- 1. Public / PAC Committee Member Comment:** None.

- 3. Crossings Update:** Not much to update since last meeting. Linda will contact Linden Clark. Tagg will dig out around bolts in preparation for removal. Lynden will be there on the eighth. ABC rentals needs to be called and reminded of the date and time, probably midmorning, whatever works for Lynden. City Works ok'd closing off street. Nash will do concrete on the 9th, but needs to know time. Taag brought a color sample and all in attendance thought it was fine.
