The purchase of a Bobcat Toolcat will allow the Parking Commission to more efficiently manage snow removal in our facilities.

History & Current Status: Impact if Canceled or Delayed

Until the winter of 2017/18 snow accumulated on the roofs of MPC garages had never been removed. The freezing and thawing of this snow has had an adverse effect of the structural integrity of the older two garages, Central Park and Bank Street structure. This is particularly true considering the mixture of the melting snow and the salt that has been used on the roofs. Removing the snow from the tops of the structures will extend the longevity of each garage. We have had difficulty borrowing equipment to complete this task and feel having our own will gives us the flexibility we need. The versatility of this machine will also assist the MPC in snow removal from our surface lots as well as distributing sand and salt on our sidewalks and parking facilities. We will be able to sweep outside parking lots with a broom attachment.
